
Indoor flying at the Domes and RC Madness is going on as scheduled. For example, on Wednesday, January 23, there were 9 flvers at the Tolland Dome. It was raining like crazy with winds up around 20 mph, but flying indoors was like every other week – regardless of the weather. All the indoor sites are also heated. If you decide to try indoor flying please consider using aircraft that will not harm the facilities or people - total all up

weight should be under 8 ounces and speeds not too fast.

The Executive Committee is trying to improve the support for the Contest Directors and will eventually be meeting with them to go over their basic needs, and how the needed support will be provided. This work should make setting up for a contest more consistent and properly funded.


