#### To Use Your Computer to Log in to the Meeting with Video and Audio:

- 1. Click on this link:

  - (If you have not previously used Zoom you may be asked to download it)
- 2. Click on the blue "Join a Meeting" button
- 3. Enter the meeting ID if requested: 841 9945 7900
- 4. Enter your first and last name as the display name so we can take attendance
- 5. Do not click on the "audio" or "video" buttons; click on the "Join" button

#### To Use Your Smart Phone to the Meeting with Video and Audio:

- 1. Download the Zoom app to your phone by either searching for it in your "App Store" or going here and scrolling to "Zoom Mobile Apps" <a href="https://zoom.us/download">https://zoom.us/download</a>
- 2. When you hear the prompt, enter the meeting ID: 841 9945 7900, followed by "#"
- 3. When prompted for the participant ID enter "#"
- 4. When prompted for the password enter: 260609, followed by "#"

#### To Use a Telephone (cell or regular) to Call in to the Meeting with Audio Only:

- 1. Dial (929) 436-2866
- 2. When you hear the prompt, enter the meeting ID: 841 9945 7900, followed by "#"
- 3. When prompted for the participant ID enter "#"
- 4. When prompted for the password enter: 260609, followed by "#"

#### If You Have a Question/Comment to Pose During the Meeting:

- If you used your computer/smart phone to log in:
  - 1. Click on the "Participants" button at the bottom of the screen
  - 2. Click on the "Raise Your Hand" button on the bottom right
  - 3. You will eventually be un-muted; after you speak click on "Lower Your Hand" OR, click on the "Chat" button at the bottom of the screen and type a comment or question.
- If you used your phone to call in:
  - 1. When there is a pause for questions, unmute yourself by clicking on the little microphone and ask your question.
  - 2. Please be patient, we will try to get to everyone.
